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# Local Residents Invited to Attend the Free Kansas City Marathon Health & Fitness Expo on October 19 & 20 at Union Station

KANSAS CITY, MO (October 2, 2017) – The Kansas City Marathon presented by Garmin will kick-off race weekend on October 19 and 20 with the free Health & Fitness Expo presented by Blue Cross and Blue Shield held at Kansas City's iconic Union Station. Over 50 vendors from the Kansas City area, and around the country, will display their health & fitness products and other merchandise while sharing their expertise with an expected 12,000 attendees. Runners/walkers can also register for any of the Kansas City Marathon's race distance options (the full marathon, half marathon, 10K or 5K) at the expo.

"Our pre-race Health & Fitness Expo is one of the biggest and best health related events in the Kansas City area each year, and we are proud to provide access to this event at no charge to the greater Kansas City community," said Dave Borchardt, Race Director for the Kansas City Marathon presented by Garmin. "Relocating the expo to Union Station gives us a cool venue for the event, and I encourage our local residents to swing by and check it out."

The Health & Fitness Expo presented by Blue Cross & Blue Shield will be held at historic Union Station in the Festival Plaza. Expo hours are Thursday, October 19 from 3 - 8 p.m. and Friday, October 20 from 11 a.m. - 8 p.m.

On race day, Saturday, October 21, thousands will descend upon Washington Square Park as runners take to the streets of Kansas City. When the runners cross the finish line, Washington Square Park will be the site of the "after party" festivities during the Finish Line Festival presented by BNY Mellon.

This family-friendly event is open to race participants, spectators and the general public. Beginning at 7 a.m., Washington Square Park, adjacent to the finish line, will transform into a party with live music, food, drinks and interactive entertainment.

#### Fit-Tastic Family Fun Zone (begins at 9 a.m.)

After the Kids Marathon presented by Chick-fil-A, kids can learn how to make healthier choices while having fun. The Kids Marathon presented by Chick-fil-A will begin at 9:30 a.m. following some fun pre-race activities including music, a mascot race and stretching and warm up.

The Kansas City Marathon presented by Garmin includes a full marathon, half marathon, 10K, 5K, and a kids marathon.
